Needless to say, it was not a relaxing way to start my time away.



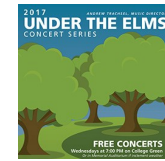

Money raised from this event helps us provide funding to support a variety of parish needs.

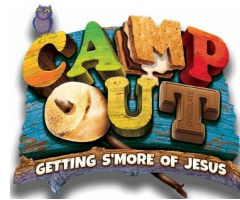

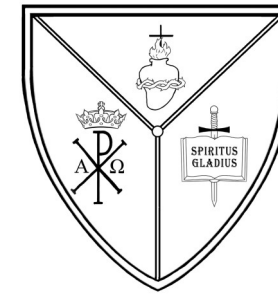
