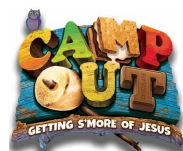

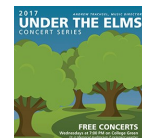


PETER'S PENCE COLLECTION - The annual collection is this weekend. There are extra envelopes by the doors to church. Thank you for your generosity!

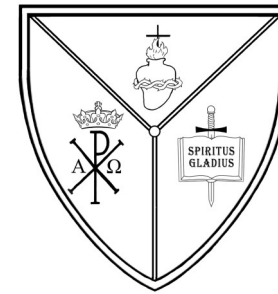
