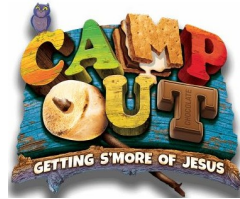

- 1.) I still have nothing to report about when Fr. Bob Kawa will arrive. His healing from knee surgery continues.
- 2.) Security and surveillance equipment is now being installed at Christ the King and the Holy Family Center. This was already in process when some person(s) shot at the glass entrance door on the Stewart Street side of the church, shattering the glass (this happened on Tuesday night or Wednesday of this past week).
- 3.) Thank you to the Knights of Columbus Msgr. Jessing Council at Sacred Heart for the purchase of the beautiful new processional crucifix in the church.
- 4.) You may remember that I was going to have some “town hall” style meetings to discuss the possibility of one parish for Athens. Because July has been such a wild month, I’m planning to reschedule those meetings for the early fall.
- 5.) For several years, we have been looking at purchasing a new house to serve as a rectory. I am pleased to tell you we have found a house within our budget, and the Diocese will close the deal this month. We are still unsure of what will become of the current rectory next to St. Paul. Here are some ideas that have been offered:

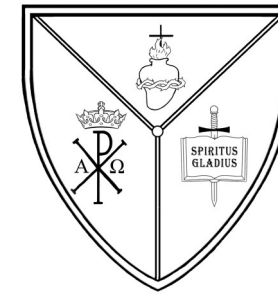
- ♦ Renting some space out to visiting professors;
- ♦ Turning it into a Catholic dorm (as many Catholic parishes affiliated with public universities across the country are doing)
- ♦ Using the bottom floor for an enlarged food pantry (we have been talking about building a new food pantry for awhile now, and this would eliminate the need to build at this time)
- ♦ Using some of the spaces as religious education classrooms

If you have any ideas about how to use the building, just let someone on the parish council or finance council know your thoughts. The new rectory is much smaller and more manageable than the current house. I hope to have a parish picnic / open house at the new place this fall.
