**NOTES FROM FR. MARK** - If you were at St. Paul last weekend, you heard both bells ringing again. On Friday of last week, the Verdin Company came and replaced the bolts in the smaller bell, so both bells are ringing once again.

DPSC Update: Thanks to all who have made pledges to this annual drive and paid (or are paying) that pledge. St. Paul Parish had a goal of \$32,695.00. Parishioners pledged \$64,010.94. As of July 25, parishioners have paid \$53,626.61. Sacred Heart Parish had a goal of \$19,028.00. Parishioners pledged \$22,454.34. To date, parishioners have paid \$17,262.00. Hopefully everyone will be able to pay their pledge. Christ the King Parish had a goal of \$40,334.00. Parishioners pledged \$54,915.33. To date, parishioners have paid \$45,861.00. Thank you for the sacrifices of your financial resources to this campaign.

As announced in last weekend's bulletin, one of the thieves who broke into the rectory was apprehended. He is to be arraigned this coming week. Apparently, this young man's accomplice was his uncle, who is still being sought by law enforcement.

This past week I was informed that Fr. Bob Kawa will not be moving into the Sacred Heart rectory. Bishop Monforton and the Diocesan Personnel Board are working on a solution. Hopefully we will have this resolved in the next two weeks.

Last weekend, we proposed a prayer movement with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. It is possible that instead of 24 consecutive hours, we could arrange two 12 hour days, beginning at 9:00 A.M. and ending at 9:00 P.M. During that time, if groups of people wanted to host particular prayers, they could. For example, at my previous parish, some people had charismatic prayer at one hour, music at another time, and devotions at other times. Remember, we are just talking about establishing a framework for prayer possibilities. While we have done many "events" in the parishes over the past several years, we haven't really had an emphasis on prayer efforts as a community.

Some upcoming events this fall:

- ♦ I will conduct a Bible study for five weeks in the fall on Matthew's Gospel.
- ♦ The Diocese is sponsoring a Rosary Congress in October (more details to come).
- ♦ Our parishes will be starting a young adult group once again.
- ♦ There are six young men who are considering a priestly vocation, and we will be starting what is called the Melchizedek Project, which is a dinner and discussion / discernment group.

We ask all experienced and those interested in becoming servers to attend. We have some new procedures, including the use of bells during Mass.

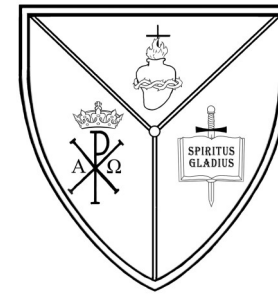
