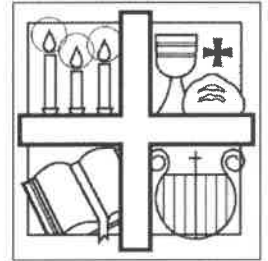
Michael Crabtree, who has been our janitor, was hired into a new job and is moving on in his life. Michael has been working in our parishes since he was 13, when he started for a few hours on Mondays with his grandfather at St. Paul. Michael just turned 29 last Thursday—so he’s worked for a total of 16 years! Michael is going to go to work for DuPont in Parkersburg. Until we decide on how to proceed with the janitorial service, we need volunteers for light cleaning around the buildings: vacuuming, dusting, mopping and sweeping floors. Supplies and instructions are provided. Sign-up sheets are posted in the churches. Thanks to those who have already volunteered!

The Gospel of Matthew Bible Study will resume on Tuesday February 13 at 10:00 AM in the Holy Family Center, and run throughout the season of Lent.

Speaking of Lent, Ash Wednesday this year lands on Feb. 14. This is highly unusual. It last happened in 1945 and after this year, will happen just two more times (2024 and 2029) before the year 2100.

It is still a day of fasting and abstinence. Ash Wednesday is one of only TWO days in the entire year that the Church tells all members to fast and abstain from meat. The other day is Good Friday. So as we begin the time of Lent, sacrifice sweets, big meals, and alcohol on Ash Wednesday, out of love for the Lord who gave up His life for us. There are other days that week (and throughout the year) for your valentine.

Candlesticks, chalices, vestments, flowers, music and other items used in the liturgy heighten an awareness of the liturgical seasons. Thus, for the Christmas and Easter seasons, we have many flowers, candles, finer vestments or chalices, and joyful music. Why all these “things”? Because we, as human beings, are physical, sensible, people! Through our senses of touch, taste, smell, sight, and sound, we are able to discover creation, ourselves, and God (and His nature). The liturgy, as an outward act and as a prayer, speaks to us through words and music, ritual actions, sight (art and architecture, vestments and physical things), smell of incense, taste of bread and wine.



The action of the liturgy and the “things” involved are not for show. Rather, they are there to engage us and take us up into the very mystery and beauty of God. The signs, symbols and sacred actions, which form our public prayer and worship, spring from the language and events of God's own self-revelation to us. Our liturgical celebrations are the means by which we enter into the mystery of God.

Since Lent is a somber and penitential season, we “go into the wilderness” with Christ, so to speak. “Austere” is the watchword for liturgical celebrations in the Season of Lent. The priest is vested in violet, the gloomy color of affliction and mortification, except on the Fourth Sunday of Lent (Laetare Sunday) when he might choose the festive option of rose vestments. The sanctuary is bereft of flowers, and less ornate linens and candlesticks adorn the altar. The Gloria is not prayed on Sunday, while the Alleluia is entirely absent throughout Lent. By this penitential ‘fast of the senses’, we prepare our hearts for a jubilant Easter renewal. Thus, you notice a simplification of the sanctuary appointments. This is not simply to move things around. The sanctuary (and the liturgy) are a catechetical means to understand and deepen our spiritual lives in this season.

The final two weeks of Lent are a time of marked liturgical preparation, when we more intensely focus on the passion and death of Our Lord. The crucifix and statues are veiled as we enter an interior phase of Lent, where we turn inward to ensure we are prepared spiritually for the ceremonies of Holy Week. Thus we prepare ourselves inwardly and outwardly for a true rebirth at Easter—a rebirth of our spiritual lives, and a rebirth of the beauty of our structures. The glories of heaven, which are opened at Easter, are seen as true glories in our own eyes.
