- & the family must be registered members of St. Paul Church or Christ the King.

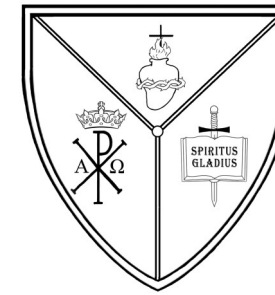
Applications are due by 5:00 PM, April 30, 2018 & should be delivered to the parish offices at 75 Stewart Street.

Fr. Mark will be leading a Bible Study on the Gospel of Matthew at 10:00 AM and 7:00 PM on Tuesdays starting this week in the Holy Family Center.

REMEMBER: Lent starts this Wednesday. Here are the guidelines for Fasting and Abstinence, from the US Bishops: *"The prescribed days of fast and abstinence are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, and the days of abstinence are every Friday of Lent. Abstinence laws consider that meat comes only from animals such as chickens, cows, sheep or pigs --- all of which live on land. Birds are also considered meat. Abstinence does not include meat juices and liquid foods made from meat. Thus, such foods as chicken broth, consomme, soups cooked or flavored with meat, meat gravies or sauces, as well as seasonings or condiments made from animal fat are technically not forbidden. However, moral theologians have traditionally taught that we should abstain from all animal-derived products (except foods such as gelatin, butter, cheese and eggs, which do not have any meat taste). Fish are a different category of animal. Salt and freshwater species of fish, amphibians, reptiles, (cold-blooded animals) and shellfish are permitted."*

*Fasting: Two small meals and one fuller meal, no eating in between meals.*
