ST. PAUL SCHOLARSHIP - Applications are now available for the St. Paul Scholarship. To be eligible for this scholarship students must:

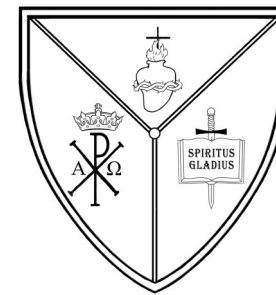
- be a graduating high school senior with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher;

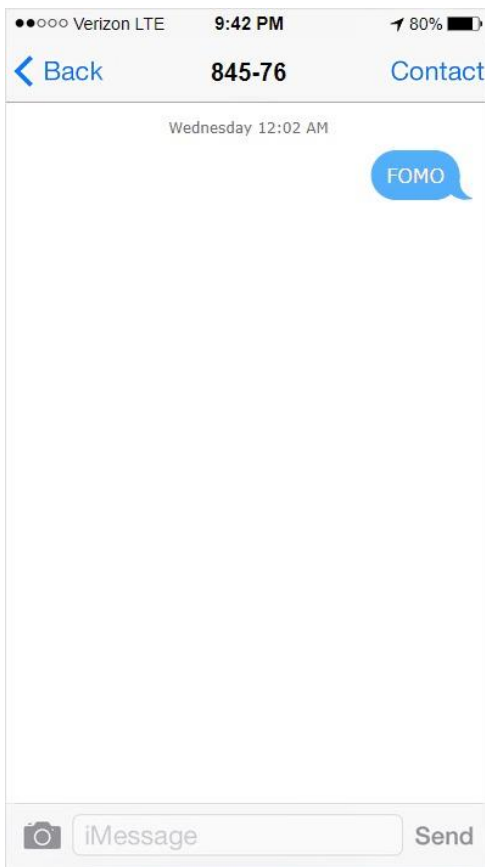
Stations of the Cross are prayed at 7:00 PM at Sacred Heart Church on the Fridays of Lent.

Tony Bruno, who directs the music at St. Paul, will be leaving our community in June. So, we are beginning the search for a new music minister. We thank Tony for all he has done, and wish him the best in his future endeavors!

The Bishop called an emergency meeting of all priests last Thursday when he found out there were some “potential irregularities” discovered during the recent reorganization of the diocesan finance office. “Irregularities appear to have occurred with the payroll system and accounting processes for an undetermined period of time. As soon as I learned of this, I engaged outside legal counsel and an accounting firm with expertise in this area to begin an immediate investigation of these issues,” Bishop Monforton said. The bishop added, “I take full responsibility for ascertaining how this happened, for resolving the situation and for ensuring it does not happen again.” The bishop said he will release more information about the results of the financial investigation as soon he receives more details. Pending completion of the investigation, the diocese will suspend any major financial expenditure, including the Holy Name Cathedral renovation project. We priests were told that these potential issues do not affect the finances of the parishes in the Diocese in any way.

For example, last week Fr. Mark was called to a meeting of diocesan priests with the Bishop at the last minute, and had to cancel Mass. He faced a challenge: How to let parishioners know Mass was being cancelled.

For several months, we have been looking at various ways to communicate with parishioners, and have found a program in use throughout the country: FLOCKNOTE. This program will send you email or text alerts to events in the parishes. I promise not to overload you with useless information!

To join, simply open up a new text message on your phone and put the number **845-76** in the ‘To:’ line where you would normally put someone’s name.

In the message box, send our text-to-join code **FOMO**. That’s all you have to do!

You’ll get a confirmation response from Flocknote welcoming you and asking you to complete your registration. You can select which ministry groups you want to hear from and sign up for spiritual growth opportunities like receiving Daily Lenten emails or to occasionally hear from Bible study groups. You can also sign up

online to receive emails if you don’t have text messaging.
