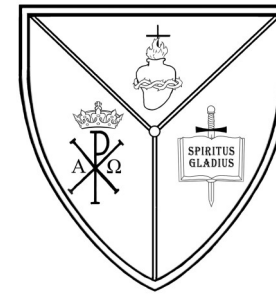

During Lent, the Rosary will be prayed before the weekend Masses.

Stations of the Cross will be prayed at 7:00 PM at Sacred Heart on the Fridays of Lent.

My apologies for no daily Masses being offered this week. I had scheduled time away, thinking Fr. Don was going to be away the following week. However, we are both scheduled to be away at the same time. It is difficult to get a priest to come and stay for a week, and we don't have the luxury of "extra" priests being close to town to help.

Recently, it was decided that our religious education students should learn a different devotion each year from our Church's treasury of devotions. This year, we are starting with devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The Catechism of the Catholic Church, quoting Pope Pius XII's beautiful encyclical *Haurietis Aquas* (1956), states, "[Jesus] has loved us all with a human heart. For this reason, the Sacred Heart of Jesus, pierced by our sins and for our salvation, 'is quite rightly considered the chief sign and symbol of that... love with which the divine Redeemer continually loves the eternal Father and all human beings' without exception (No.478).

To appreciate this rich symbolism of the heart, we must remember that in Judaism the word heart represented the core of the person. While recognized as the principle life organ, the heart was also considered the center of all spiritual activity.

Devotion to the Sacred Heart was practiced through our Church's history in hope of restoring peace to a world shattered by political and religious persecution. St. Margaret Mary Alacoque received special apparitions of Jesus, who revealed His loving Heart. In 1899, Pope Leo XIII consecrated the world to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Since then, his successors have exhorted the faithful to turn to the Sacred Heart and make acts of personal consecration. They have also begged the faithful to offer prayers and penances to the Sacred Heart in reparation for the many sins of the world. While meditating on the Sacred Heart of Jesus, we are called to share in the love of the Lord and strive to express our own genuine love for God, ourselves and our neighbors.

Through the generosity of a parishioner, prayer cards in plastic holders are offered at the doors of the church for any parishioner to take home. All of our families in the children's religious education program have received these to pray every day. They are three short lines that help us to honor the love of Jesus in our homes and our families.

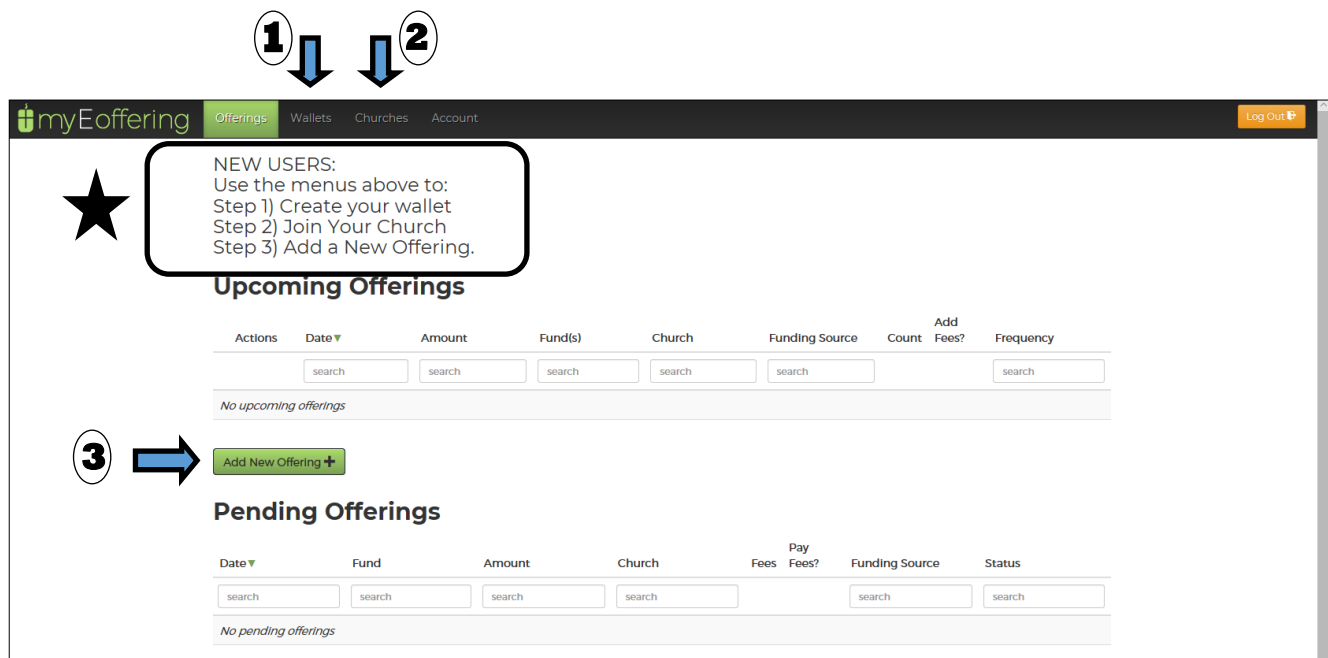

Once you have created and verified your account, follow these steps to begin contributing! Thank you for your patience and generosity.

- 1) Once you are logged in, click on the 'Wallets' tab at the top of the page to put in credit card or checking account information
- 2) Select the 'Churches' tab at the top of the page to join a church (or churches). You can search by name, city, or state
- 3) Under the 'Offerings' tab, select the 'Add New Offering' button in the middle of the page
- 4) Choose the church to which you would like to contribute
