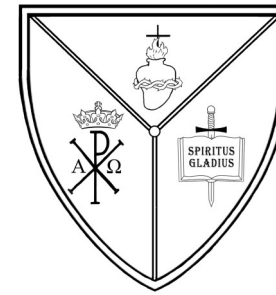

Happy Easter! Thanks to the servers, choir members, readers, extraordinary ministers of communion, decorators and all who helped in this week's liturgies. Your help greatly enhances our worship of God and our immersion in the mysteries we celebrated.

You may notice at Sacred Heart there is a new baptismal font. The previous font was falling apart and was so small that it was hard to baptize people (especially older children and adults) in it. When we were cleaning out the old church in Long Bottom, I discovered the original wood carved font from Sacred Heart. You can see this font pictured in the dedication photo of the church. This font was given by the St. Aloysius Young Men's Society, who also donated the second window on the right hand side of the church. At some point this font was removed from the church and given to the church in Long Bottom. Bob Smith and Don Frymyer brought the font back and Emerson Heighton, George Korn and David Heighton sanded and refinished it. Pete Brooker donated the new bowl for the font. It is truly a beautiful piece and we are glad to have it back—thanks to those involved for their efforts!



If you missed the announcement at Mass or in the Steubenville Register, Fr. Tom Nelson will be moving to our parishes as resident assistant June 10. As parochial vicar, he will reside in Athens, and help at all three parishes. Fr. Tom is known to us, and we are happy to have him come and minister in a full time capacity.

The Drive Weekend for the Diocesan Parish Share Campaign is April 7 and 8. You should be receiving a letter from me regarding this annual appeal. If we get substantial rebates, we will be replacing one of the HVAC units on the Holy Family Center, repairing the concrete sidewalk on the Mill Street side of St. Paul, and getting new windows in the basement hall at Sacred Heart.

One of the HVAC units keeps breaking down in the Holy Family Center, usually on the day of Adoration! We did not replace them when renovating the Center several years ago, because we knew they had a few good years left in them (and waiting allowed us to save up some money for the eventual replacement). The windows in the hall at Sacred Heart need to be replaced with something more efficient, thus eliminating the rotting frames and acrylic sheets put over them. The concrete patches made by the city to the sidewalks at St. Paul on the Mill Street side of the church have been giving way and crumbling.
