Encourage us, we pray, in our struggle for justice, love and peace.

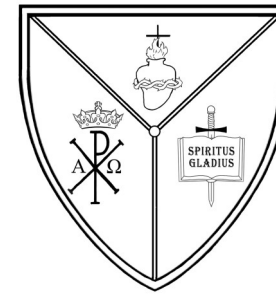
