DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY - Celebrated on the Octave of Easter (the Sunday after Easter Sunday), the feast was established on April 30, 2000, when Saint Pope John Paul II canonized Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska. There are a number of devotions associated with Divine Mercy Sunday, and some, including the Divine Mercy Novena and the Divine Mercy Chaplet, are practiced throughout the year. The chaplet, in particular, makes an excellent daily devotion, especially if it can be recited at 3 PM -- the time of Our Lord's Passion and Death on the Cross.

Next Sunday, April 8th, we will have confessions and Adoration from 2:00 to 3:00 PM, and the Divine Mercy Chaplet and Benediction will be prayed at 3:00 PM at St. Paul Church.

Throughout Saint Faustina's life, she reported a number of visions of Jesus and conversations with him, which she wrote about in her diary, later published as the book *Diary: Divine Mercy in My Soul*. At age 20 she joined a convent in Warsaw. Faustina, and her spiritual director, Fr. Sopocko, directed an artist to paint the first Divine Mercy image, based on Faustina's reported vision of Jesus. The image shows Jesus with rays of red and pale light streaming from the area around His heart. His right hand is raised in blessing, recalling the scene of Easter Sunday night (see Jn 20: 19-23). The rays represent the blood and water which flowed from His pierced side, and He taught Blessed Faustina the prayer: "O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You" (Diary, 84).

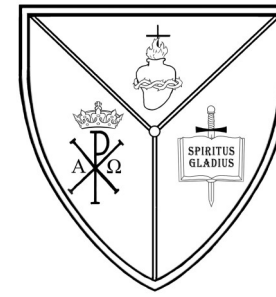

Diocesan / Parish Share Campaign 2018

Our goals this year are:

St. Paul: \$35,294

Christ the King \$41,030

Sacred Heart: \$19,029

These amounts are the total we must pay to the Diocese. Anything over this amount is returned to us, free from any assessment by the Diocese.

This week, you will be receiving a mailing from me with a pledge card. I ask you to please fill out the card and bring it back to church with you over the next two or three weeks.

You can drop the card in the collection basket at Mass, or mail it back to the office.

Please make your check payable directly to the Diocese of Steubenville and NOT to the parish. You can pay at once or by installments. The Diocese also has an online credit card payment option. Go to ww.diosteub.org/giveonline to use this system. We do not have the ability to give to the DPSC through our parish online giving program.

What are we going to do with any refund that we receive?

This year, we hope to use the St. Paul refund to replace of parts of the crumbling concrete sidewalk on the Mill Street side of the church. We will also use the money to fix some electrical issues in the church.

At Christ the King, we hope to use the refund money to replace the irreparable HVAC unit on the Holy Family Center.

At Sacred Heart, we hope for a refund to replace the windows in the basement hall.

Every donation is important and helps us achieve our goal and receive a refund. Because we do not have typical parish fund raisers like raffles or bingo, this yearly drive helps us to do maintenance work that would otherwise require a special collection. Please consider helping in this annual appeal. Thank you!
