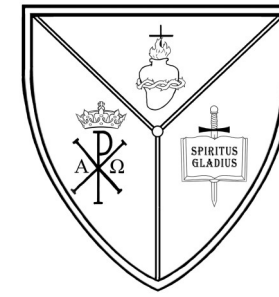

Thanks to the anonymous parishioner who contributed a relic of St. Pius X (and accompanying paperwork) in the collection at CTK. St. Pius was the two hundred fifty-ninth pope, serving from 1903-1914. He placed a renewed liturgical emphasis on the Eucharist, saying, "Holy Communion is the shortest and safest way to Heaven." To this end, he encouraged frequent reception of Holy Communion. This also extended to children who had reached the "age of discretion." Pius also gave great impetus to biblical studies, started a liturgical reform, and brought about the codification of Canon Law. His overriding concern was taken from his motto, "to renew all things in Christ." His last will and testament bears the striking sentence: "I was born poor, I have lived in poverty, and I wish to die poor." His feast day is August 21.

The 6:00 PM Sunday night Mass moves to St. Paul next weekend. Why do we move the Mass in the summer? The summer crowd is smaller, and since St. Paul is the smaller church, the Mass doesn't feel as empty in there! Most of the summer, the parts of the Mass and hymns will be sung a cappella.
